### **EMCS Phase 4.0 Status**



- Main Phase 4.0 change: computerisation of B2B duty paid movements and the use of an electronic simplified administrative document (e-SAD).
- SEED, aligned to Phase 4.0, in production since February 2022
- New Administrative reference code (ARC) structure
  - Removal of value 'P' in position 20 of the ARC for duty suspension movements from January 2023
  - Use of value 'P' in position 20 of the ARC for **duty paid** movements from February 2023
- EMCS Phase 4.0 in production from **13 February 2023**



#### Implementation delays



- Netherlands National Excise application will not be ready to support some EMCS Phase 4.0 functionalities by 13/02/2023.
  - SEED will be compliant with the Phase 4.0 requirements; new operator types will be registered in SEED;
  - National EMCS converter will be used for Duty-suspended movements of excise goods;
  - Fall back procedures will be applied for Duty paid B2B movements.
- Northern Ireland National Excise application will not be ready to support some EMCS Phase 4.0 functionalities by 13/02/2023.
  - Functionalities of Duty-suspended movements of excise goods will not be impacted;
  - Fall back procedures will be applied for Duty paid B2B movements.



#### Fallback procedures



- No legislative changes regarding the EMCS fallback procedures;
- Movements started in fallback will have to be closed by alternative means;
- Phase 4.0 movements started as e-SAD or e-AD and destined to a delayed NA (Phase 3.4) will have to be closed :
  - by electronic report of receipt (IE818) which must be converted from Phase 3.4 to 4.0;
  - based on alternative evidence, e.g. using manual closure;
- Paper based SAAD procedure will be withdrawn from 13/02/2023.



### SEED for EMCS Phase 4.0

- New operator types for Duty Paid:
  - Certified consignor
  - Temporary Certified consignor;
  - Certified consignee;
  - Temporary Certified consignee;
- <u>SEED on Europa</u> alignment with the new operator types as of February 2023





#### EMCS Phase 4.1



- Scope of AES EMCS interface agreed September 2022;
- EMCS Phase 4.1 Functional and technical specifications will be published in January 2023;
- EMCS Phase 4.1 is planned to be in production from February 2024,
